

SERIOUS COMPLICATIONS ARE POSSIBLE.

\*Those at HIGH RISK include: young children, people 65 years and older, pregnant women, and people with certain chronic medical conditions (like asthma, diabetes, heart disease, weakened immune systems, and neurological conditions).
