At least once every 4 years, the department shall review each county land conservation committee's compliance with s. 91.82 to monitor landowner compliance with the conservation requirements of the Farmland Preservation Program (FPP). A county LCC shall inspect each farm owner claiming FPP tax credits at least every 4 years for compliance with s. 91.80, Wisc. Stats.

We conduct these reviews to learn if the performance standards and compliance monitoring for FPP are being followed and if DATCP can assist counties with program administration or training.
